Personalised Learning Targets

Rather than learner working through a whole grade at a time, they are each set bespoke learning targets in each of their subjects.

This means that learning is personalised, allowing for both stretch and challenges, as well as over learning to take place.



The learning ladder of progress





We can imagine learning as a ladder of progress.

Each time a student makes progress, this is captured using our assessment system through photographs, videos and staff written testimonies



This evidence added contributes towards learners progressing up the learning ladder of grades and steps.







The grades and steps system we use in school progress from Pre-Key Stage (P) to grades and steps, from 1 to 6.


Each grade is divided into 6 key steps, in order to ensure that students have the ability to develop their knowledge until this is secure; at this point, they will then progress to the next grade.

At the end of each term, students progress is tracked and they are assigned a letter in accordance with their attainment . . .











Progress towards the future






Grades and steps can be converted to outcomes at Key Sage 4, when your child leaves Discovery.

There is a strong correlation between the amount of progress your child makes and the outcome in terms of a grade. The progress your child makes takes into consideration their attitude in learning.




If you child is working within Pre-Grade 3 to 8, it is predicted that they will go on to sit Entry Level 1 qualifications at Key Stage 4.



If you child is working within grades 4-6, it is predicted that they will go on to sit Level 1, Level 2 and GCSE qualifications at Key Stage 4.


